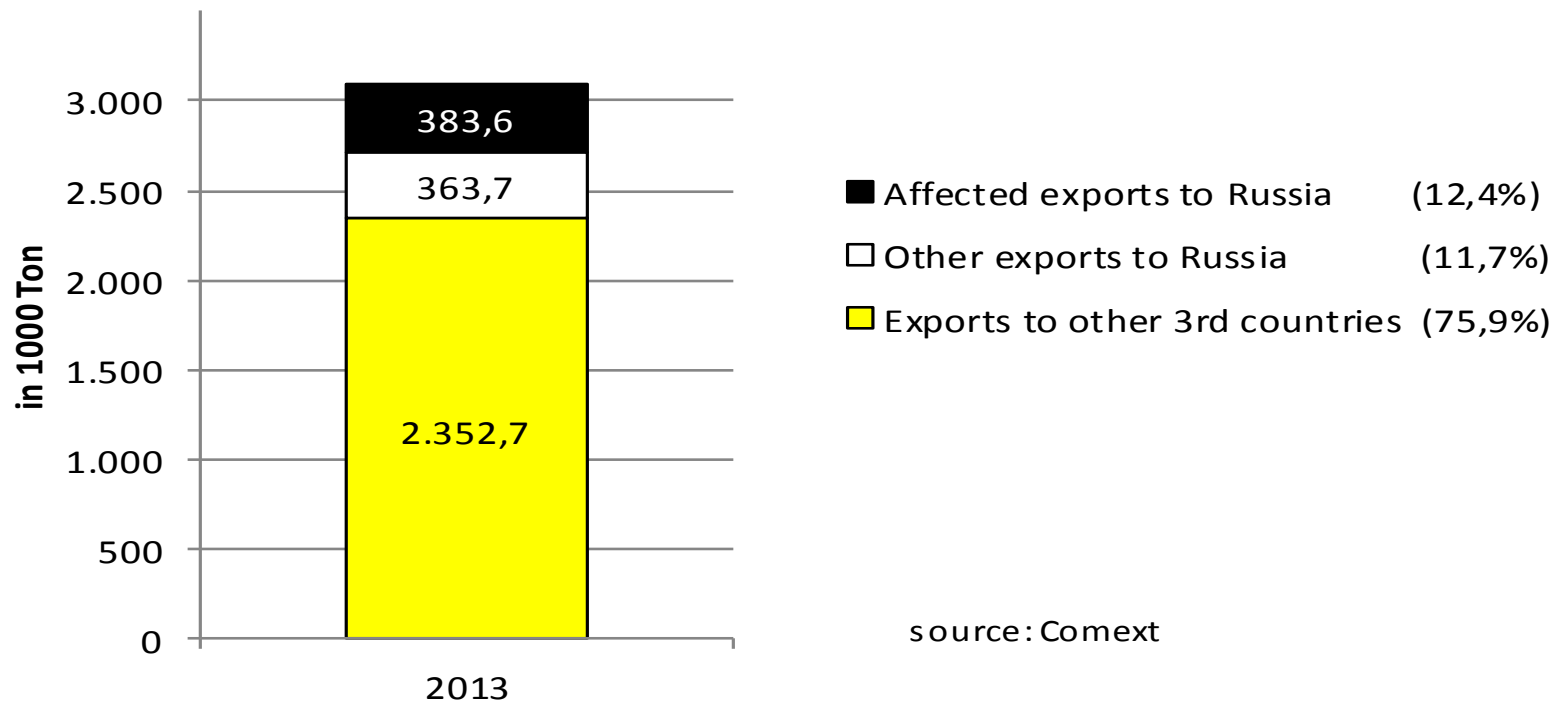

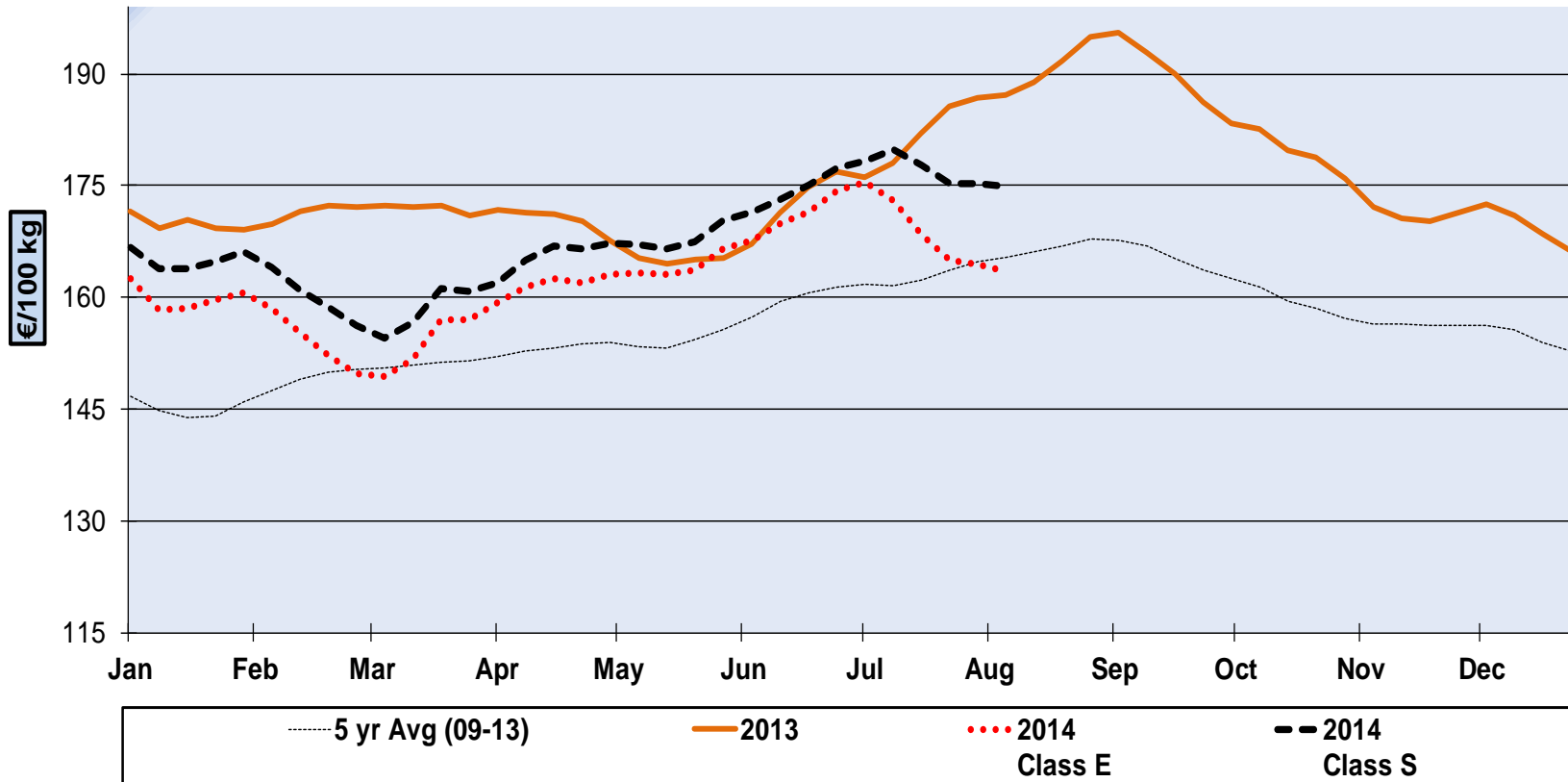
EU export of Pig meat and Saussages

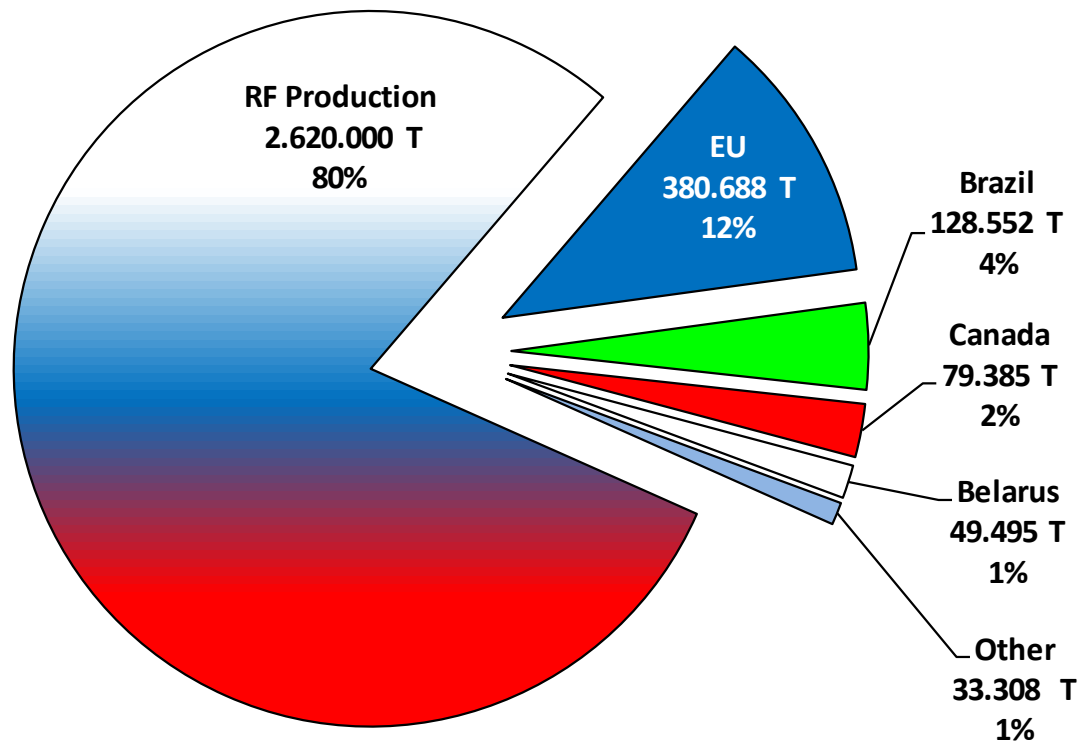

Russian supply of pigment (2013)



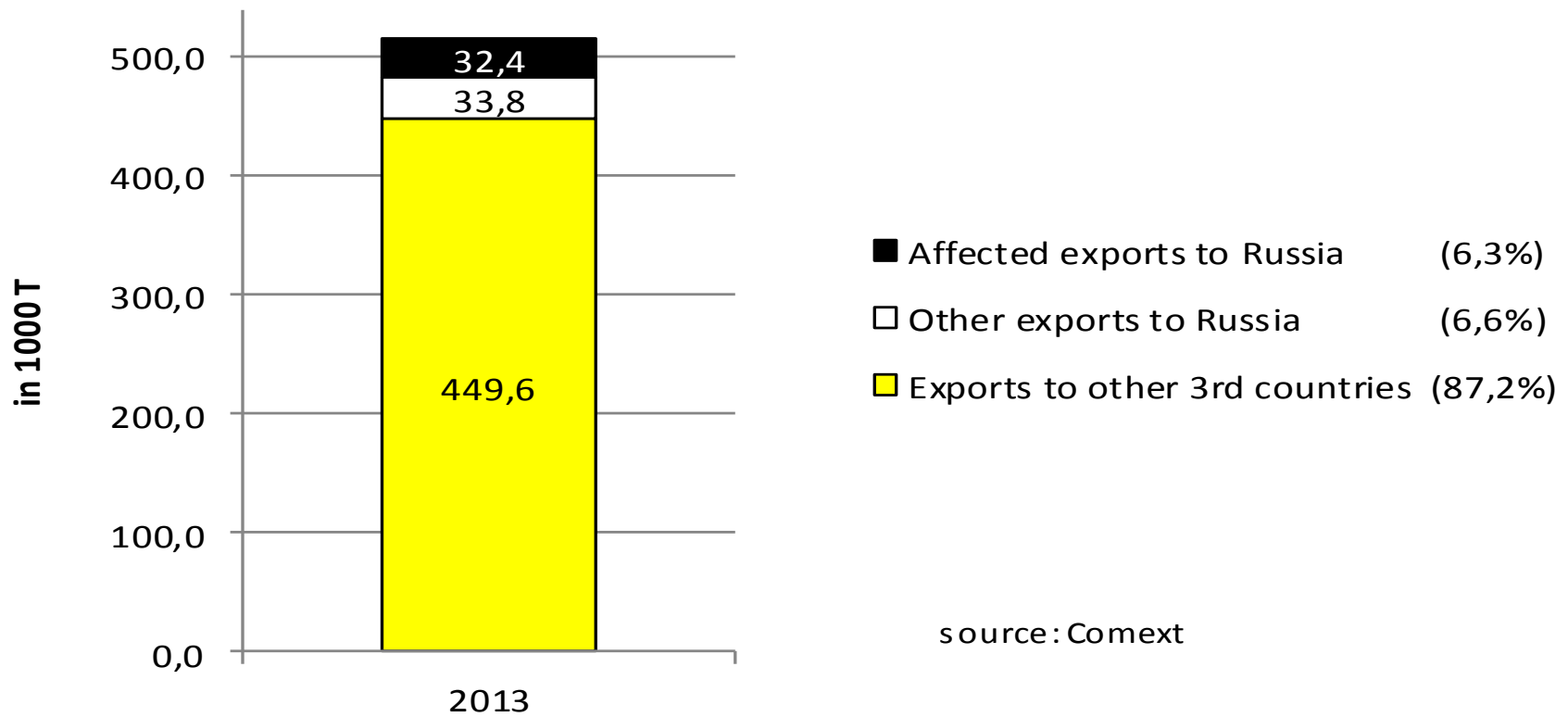

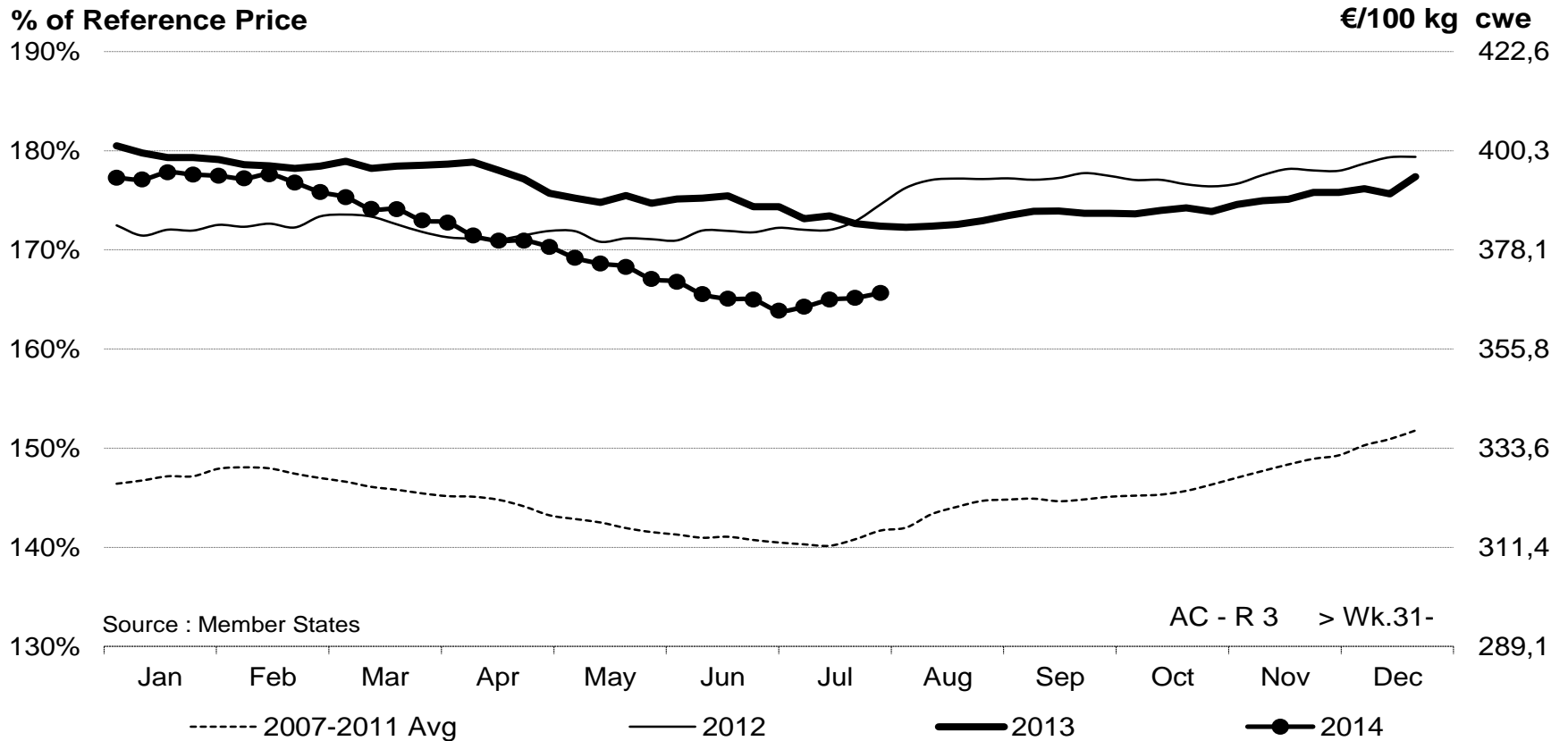

EU export of Beef & veal

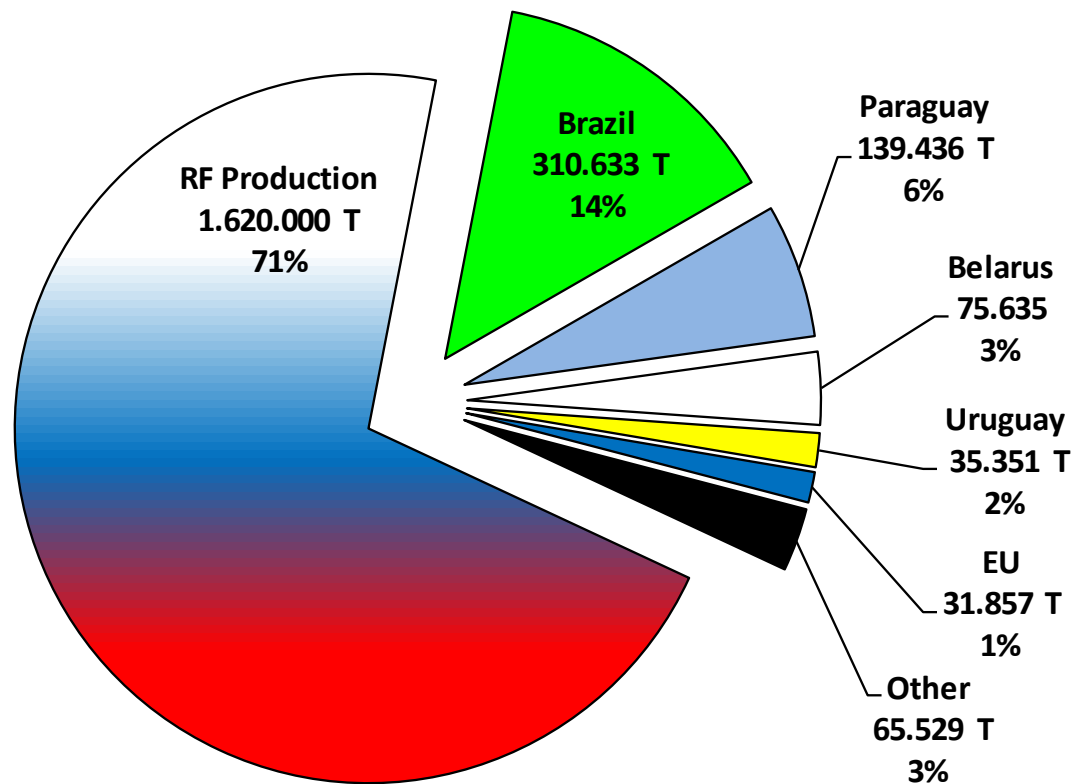

Russian supply of beef & veal (2013)



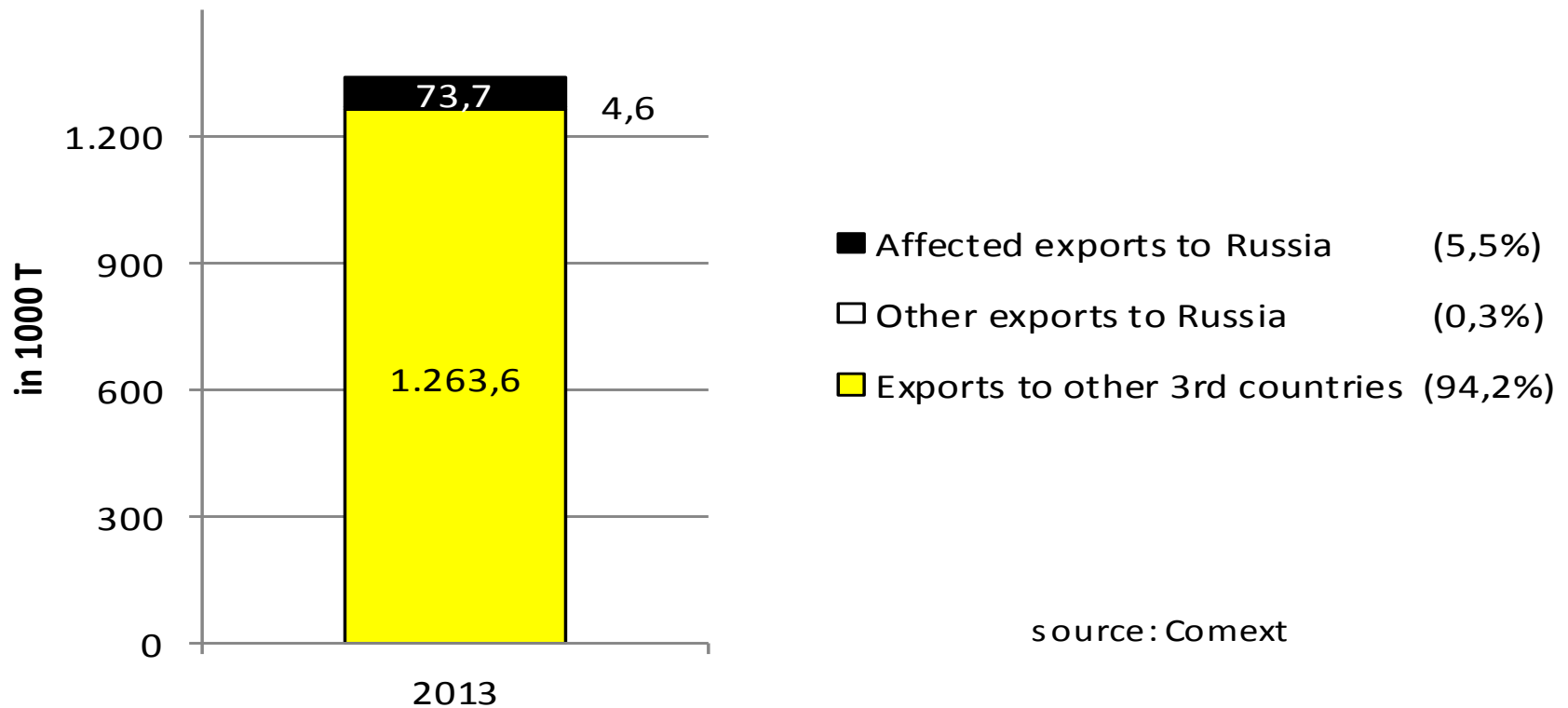

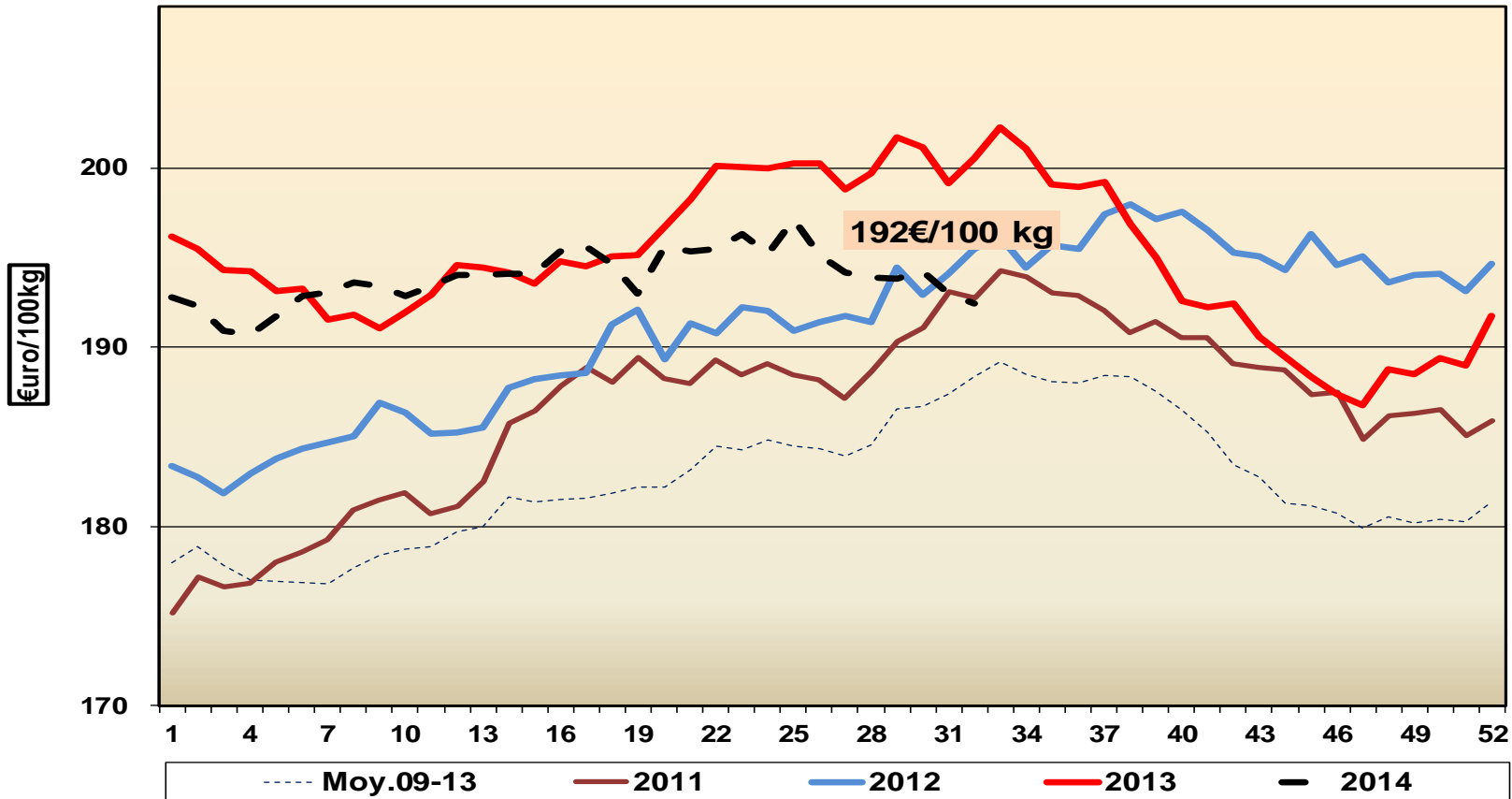

EU export of poultry meat

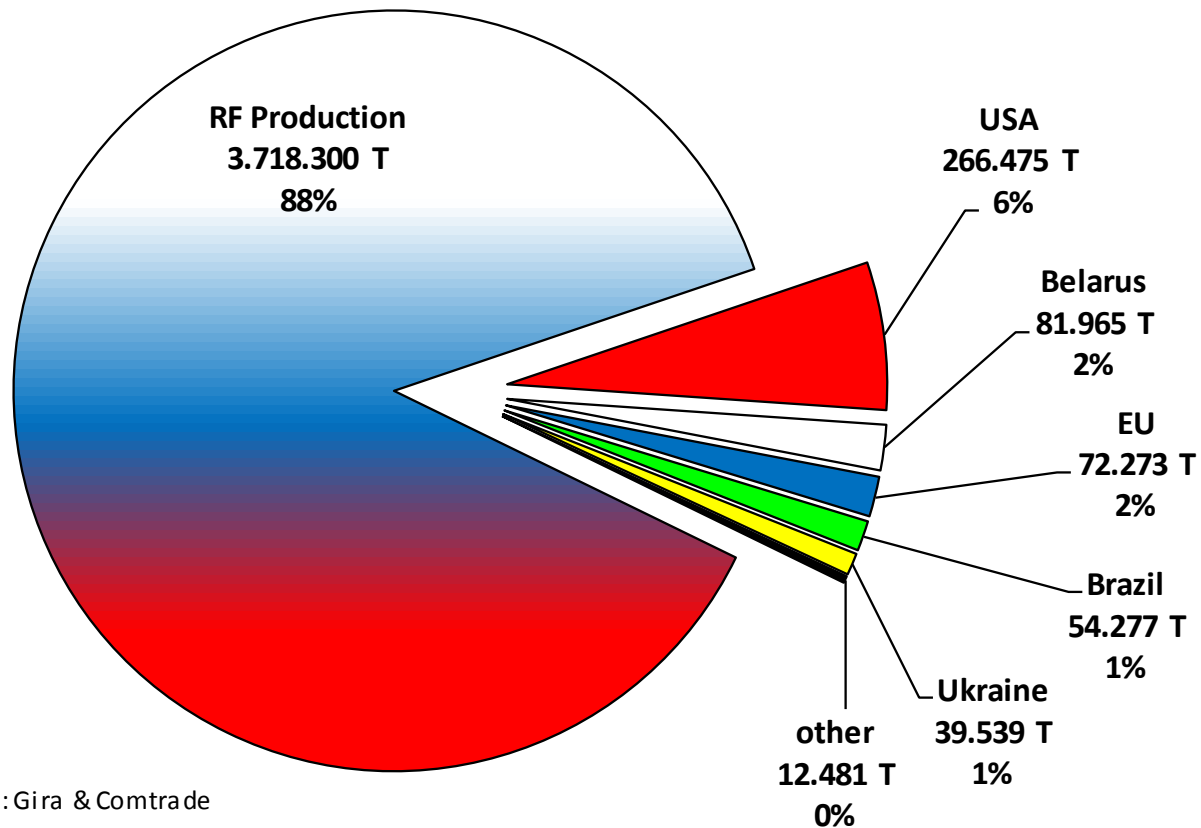
